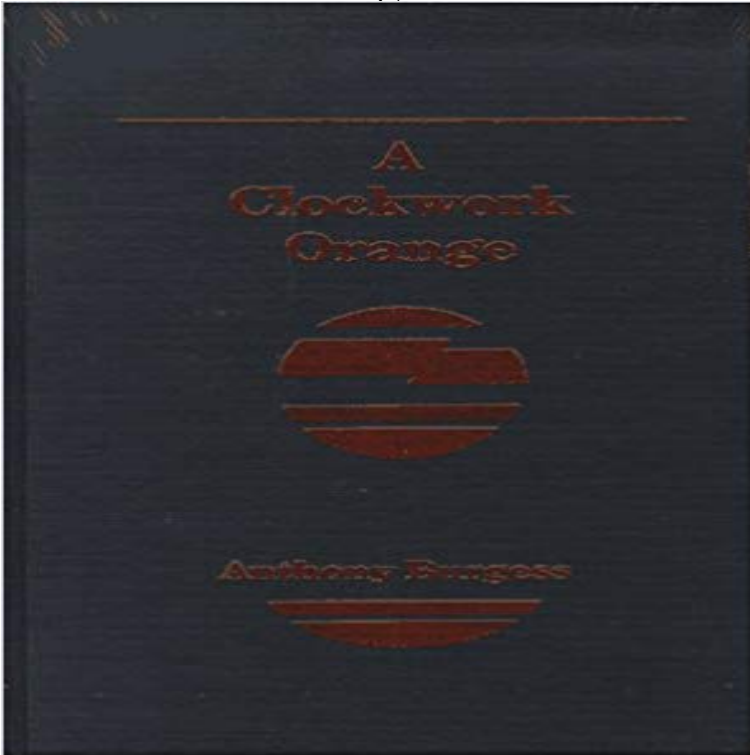


A Clockwork Orange
