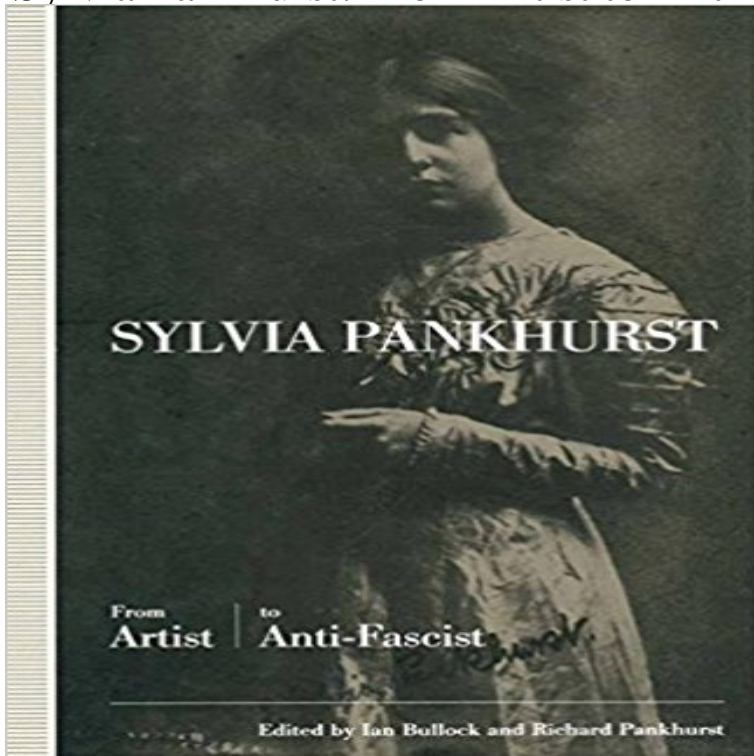


Sylvia Pankhurst: From Artist to Anti-Fascist
