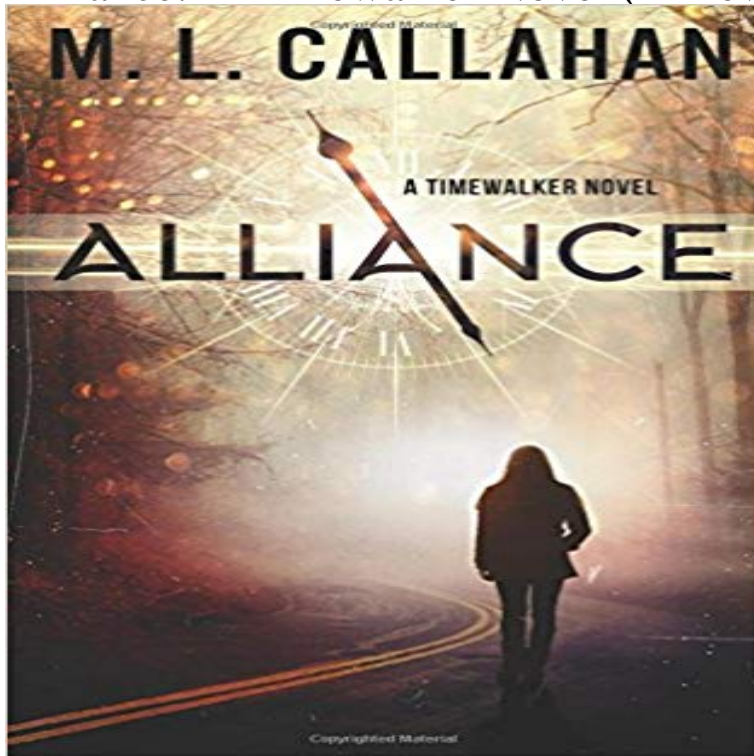


Alliance: A Timewalker Novel (Timewalker Chronicles) (Volume 1)
