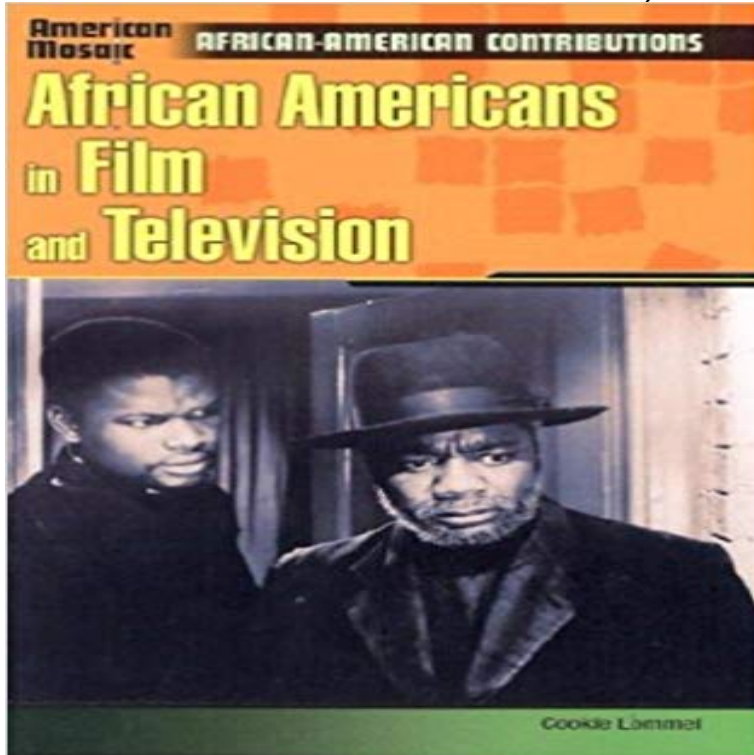


African American in Film and Television (American Mosaic: African-American Contributions)
