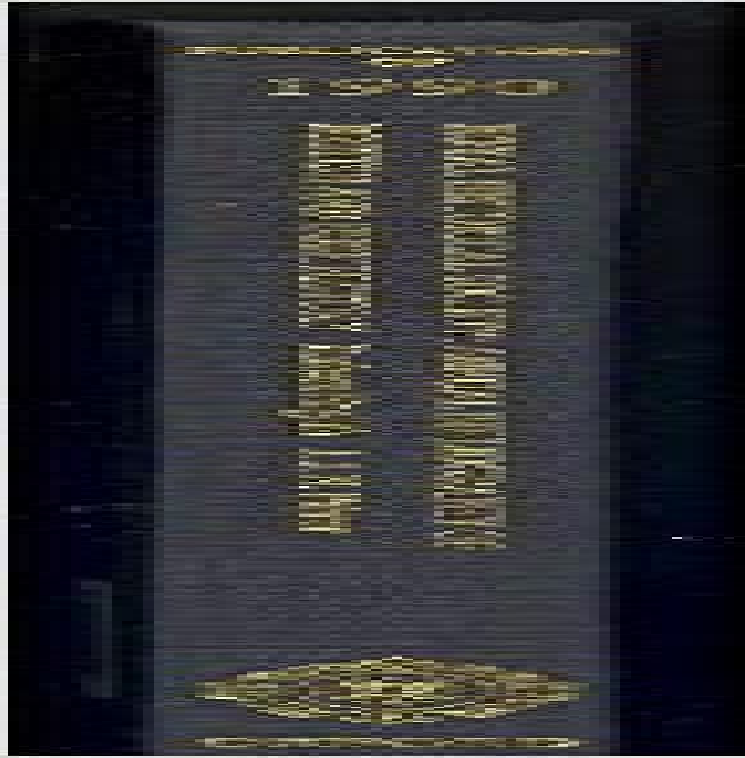


Royal Historical Society Annual Bibliography of British and Irish History: Publications of 1990
