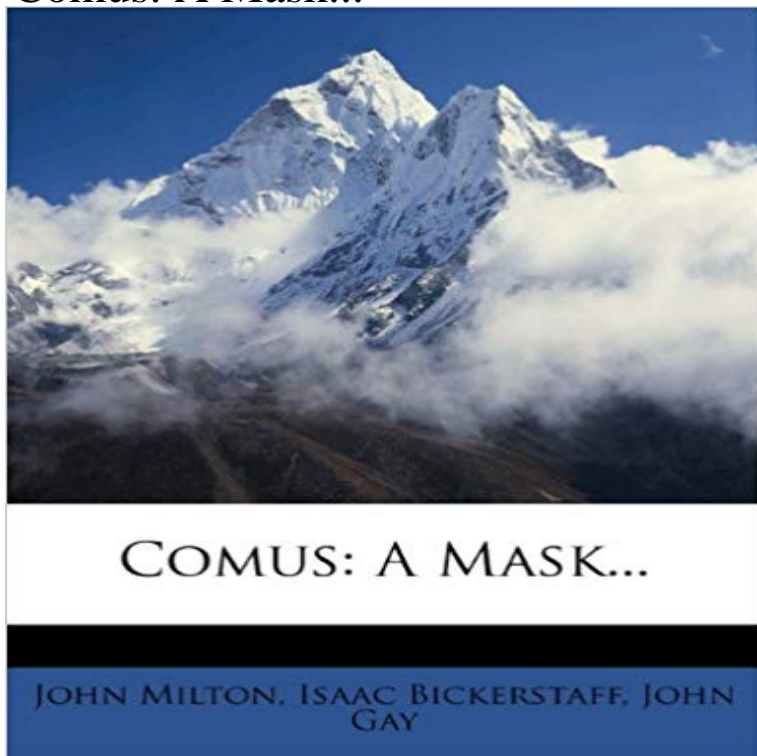


Comus: A Mask...
