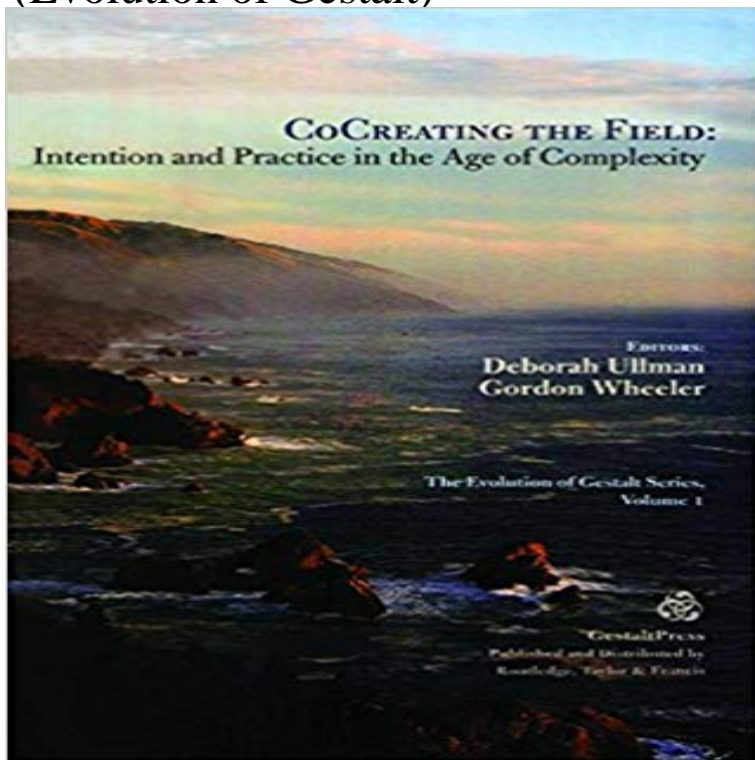


CoCreating the Field: Intention and Practice in the Age of Complexity (Evolution of Gestalt)
