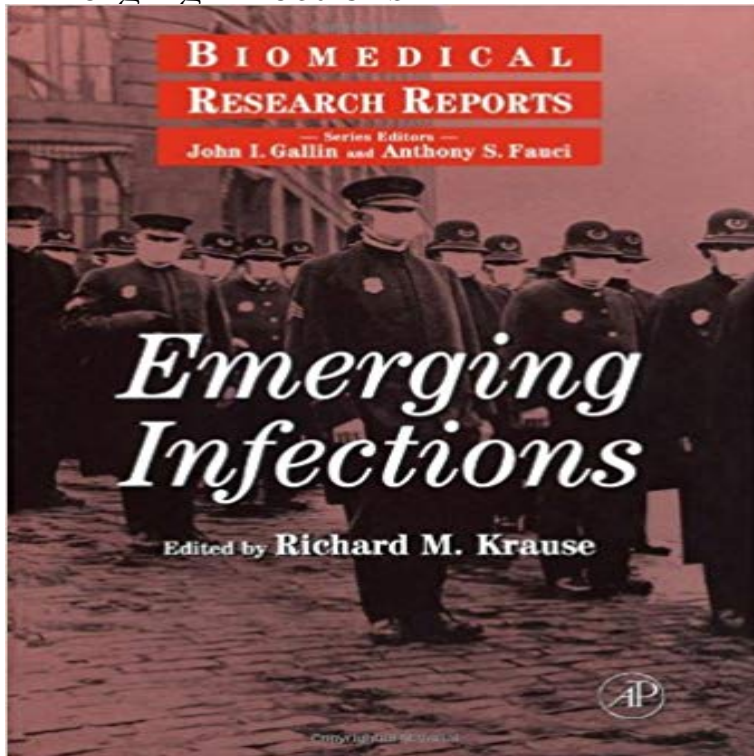


Emerging Infections
