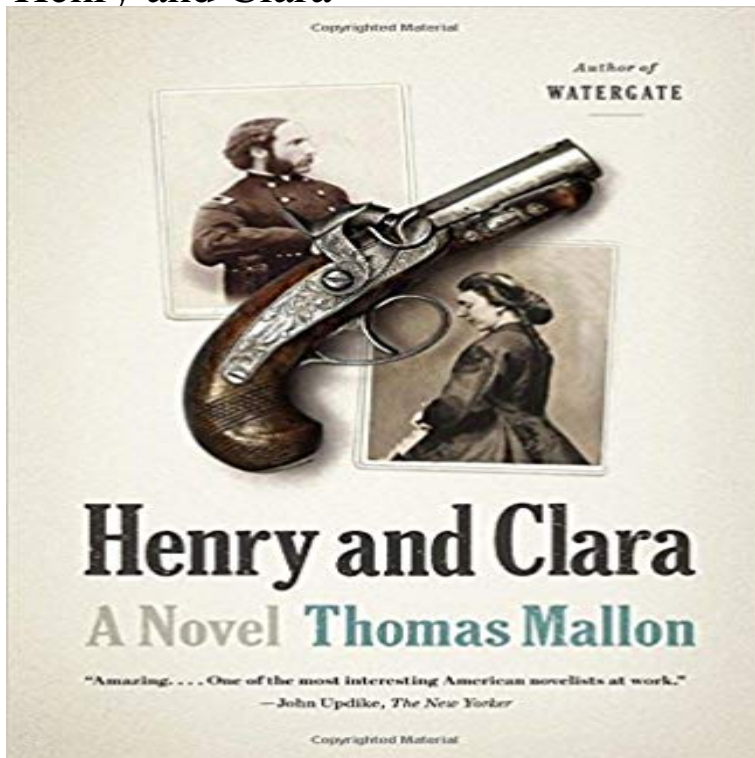


Henry and Clara
