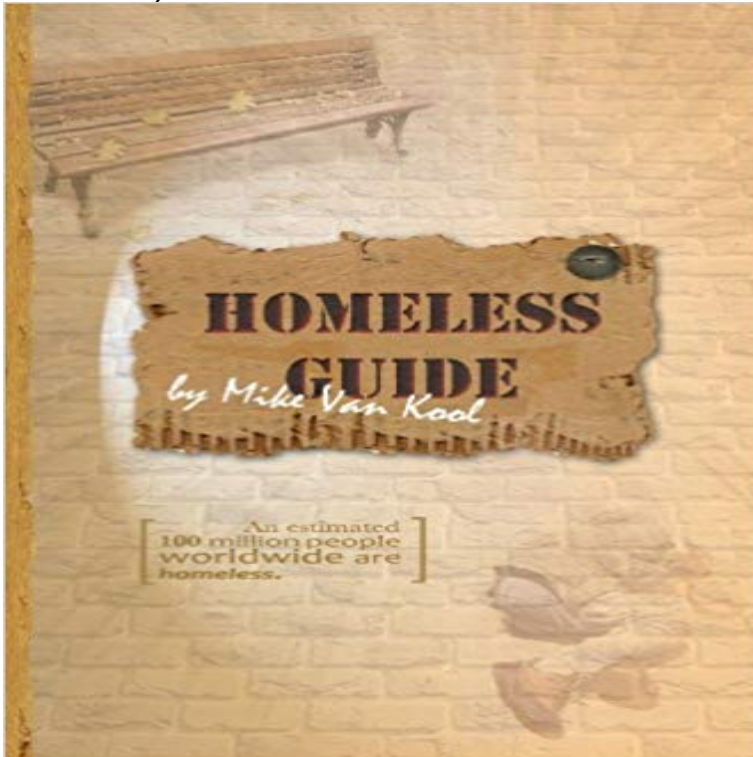


# Homelessness: Homeless Guide (Homelessness in America Collection Book 1)
