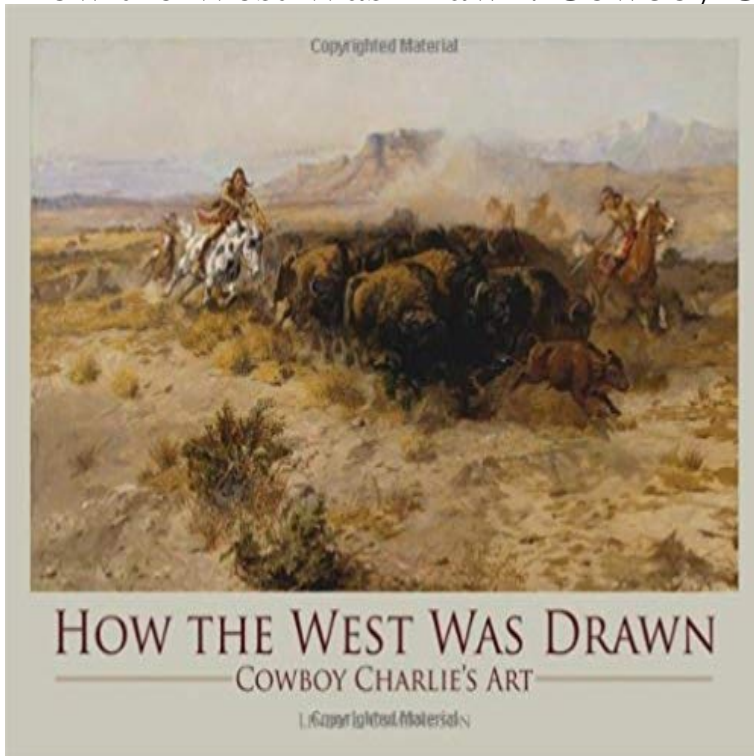


How the West Was Drawn: Cowboy Charlies Art
