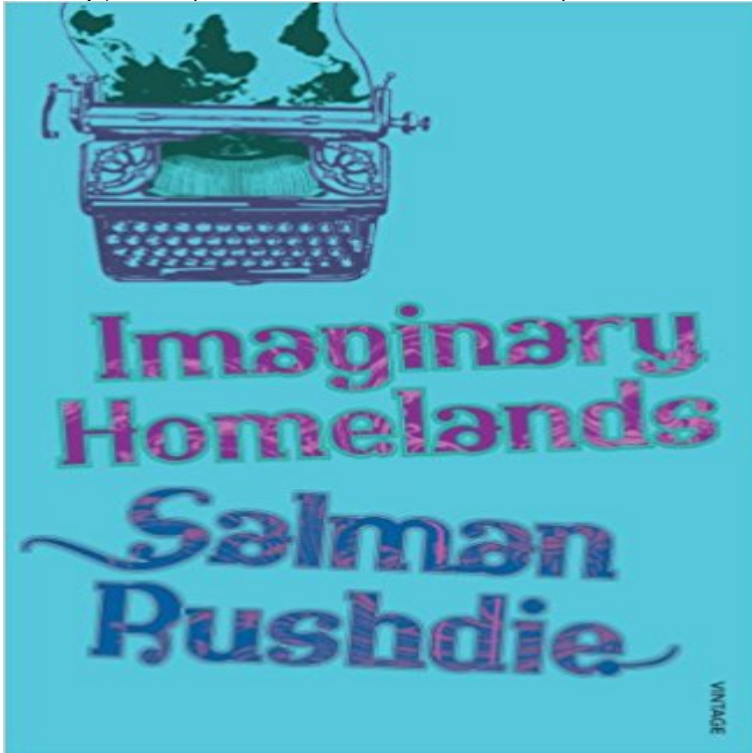


Imaginary Homelands: Essays and Criticism 1981-1991
