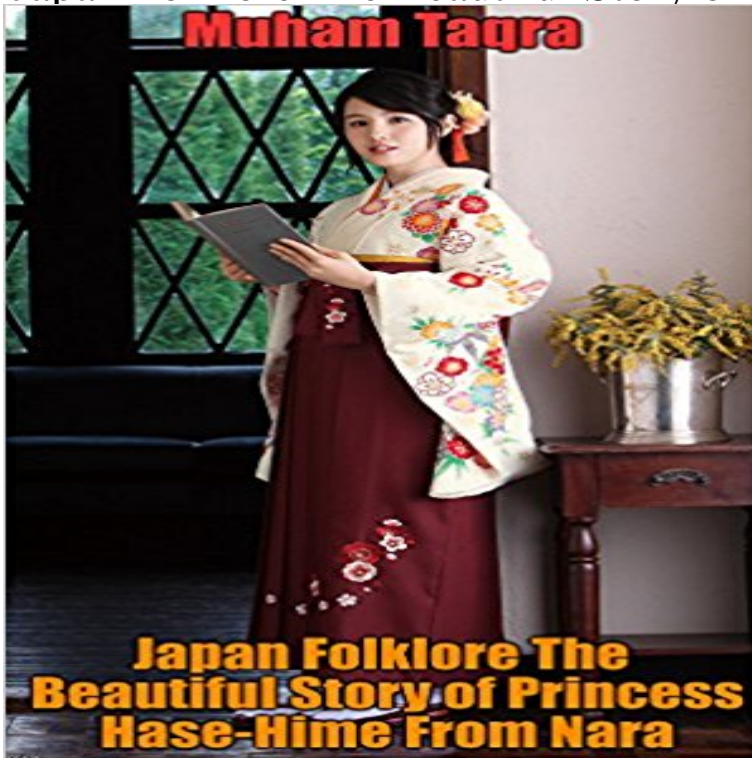


Japan Folklore The Beautiful Story of Princess Hase-Hime From Nara
