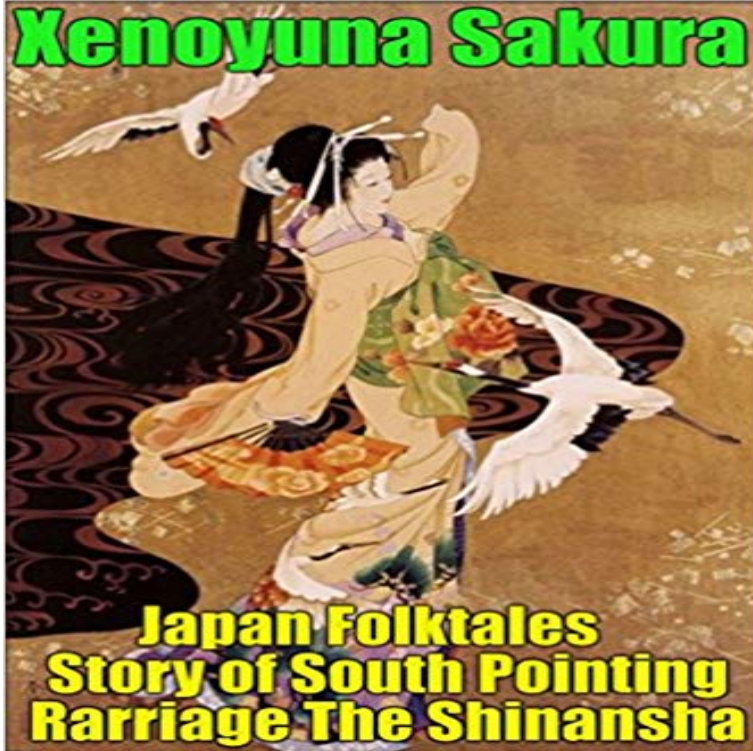


Japan Folktales Story of South Pointing Rarriage The Shinansha
