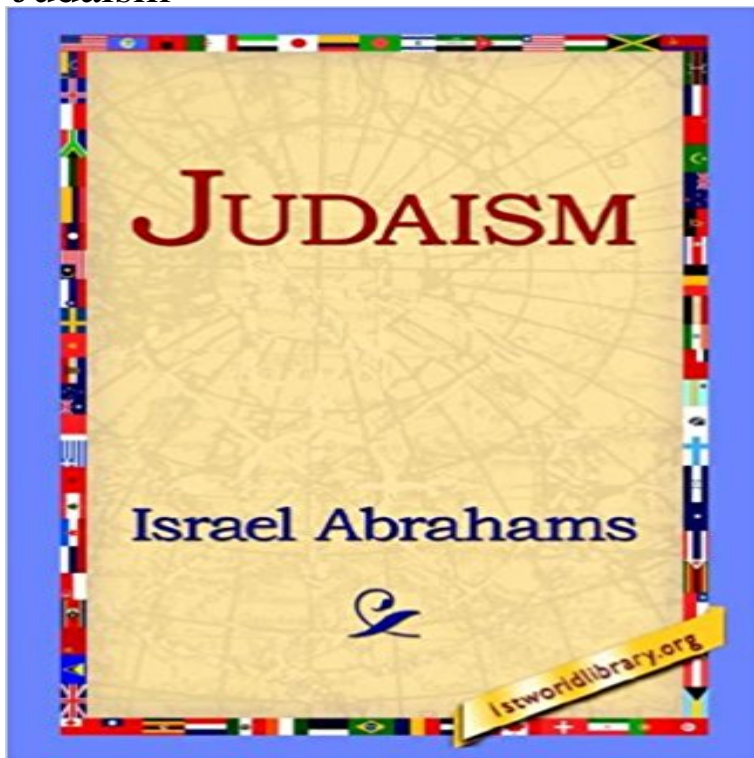


Judaism
