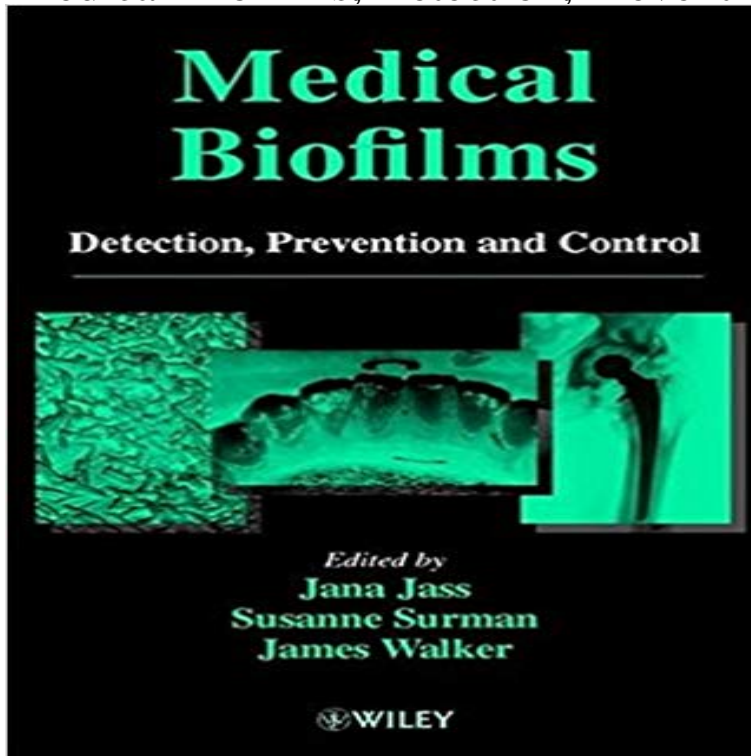


## Medical Biofilms, Detection, Prevention and Control (Vol 2)
