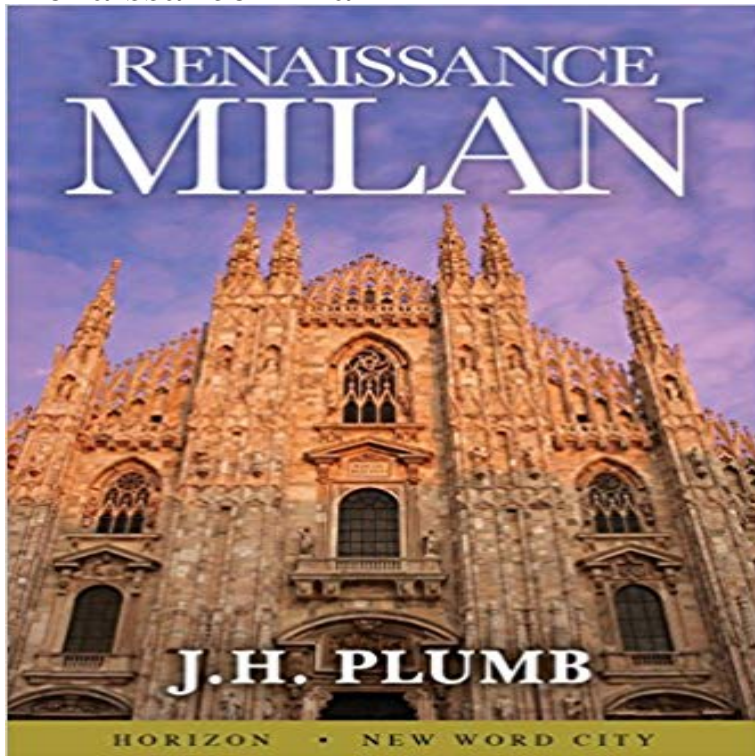


## Renaissance Milan
