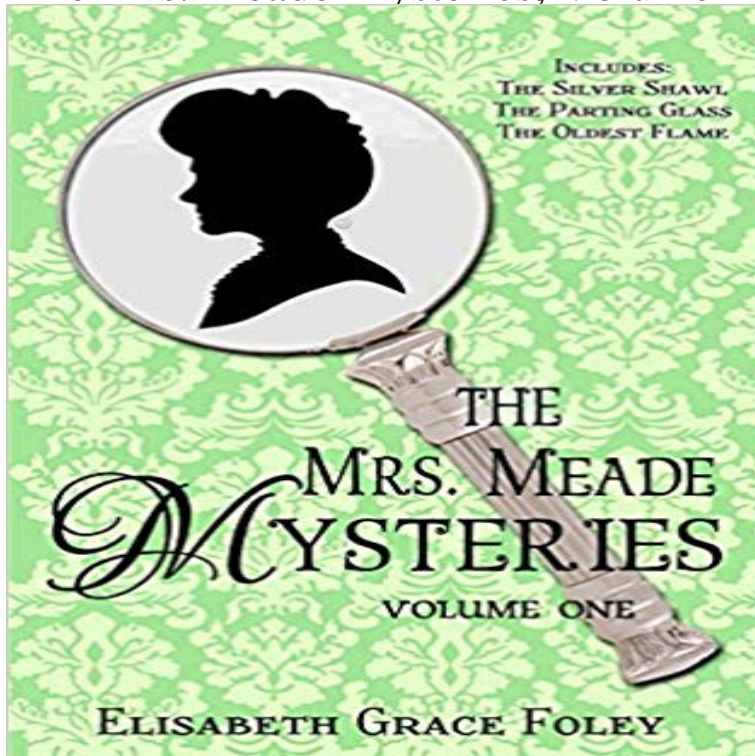


The Mrs. Meade Mysteries, Volume I
