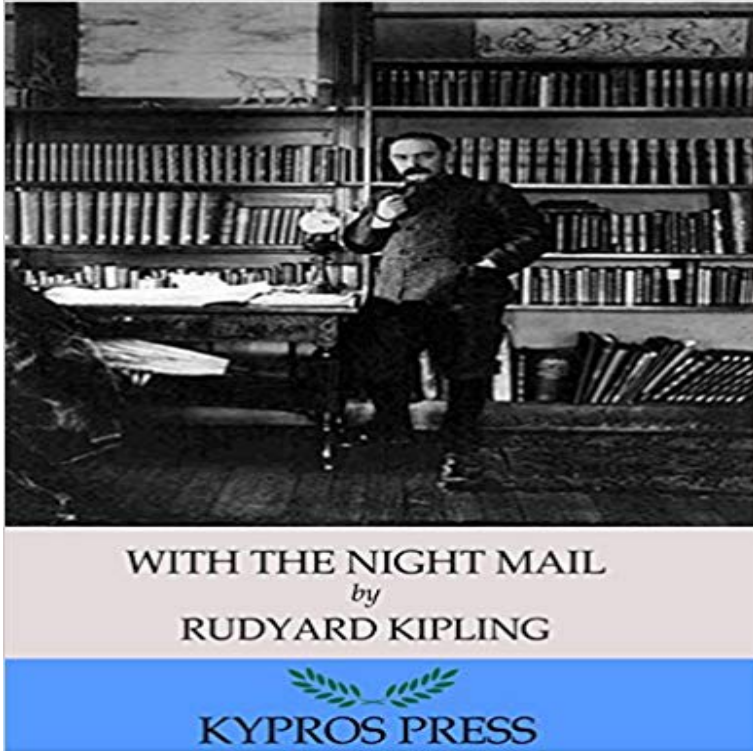


With the Night Mail
