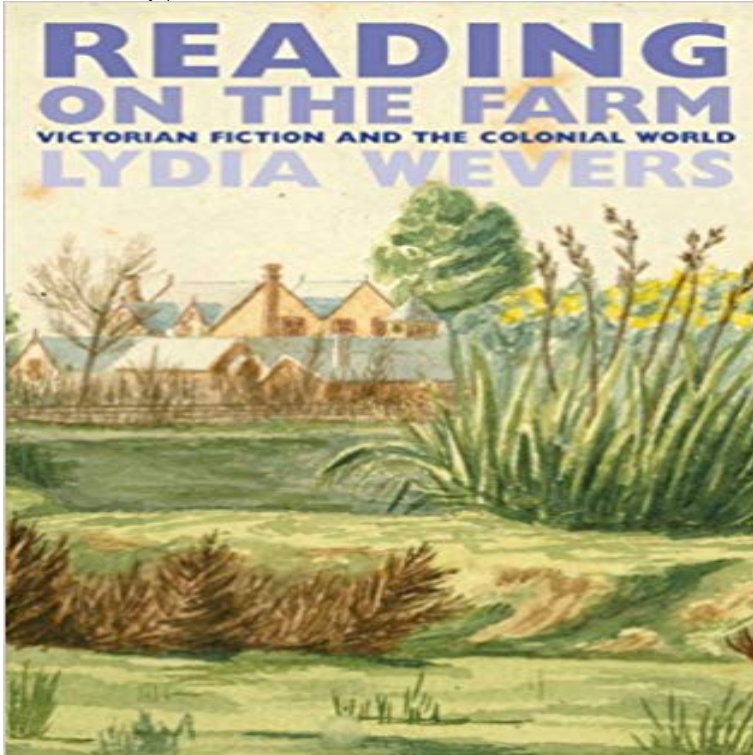


Reading on the Farm: Victorian Fiction and the Colonial World
