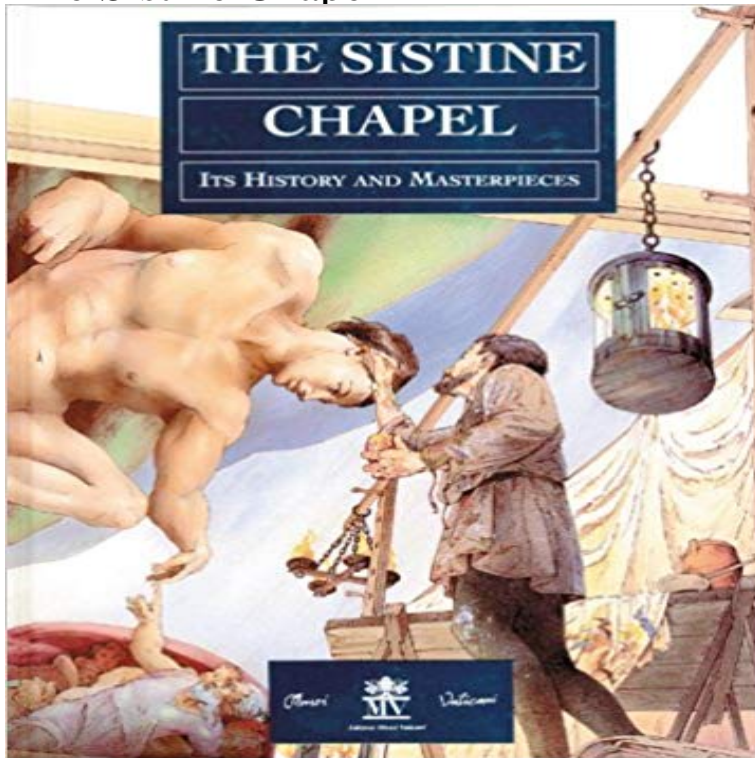


The Sistine Chapel
