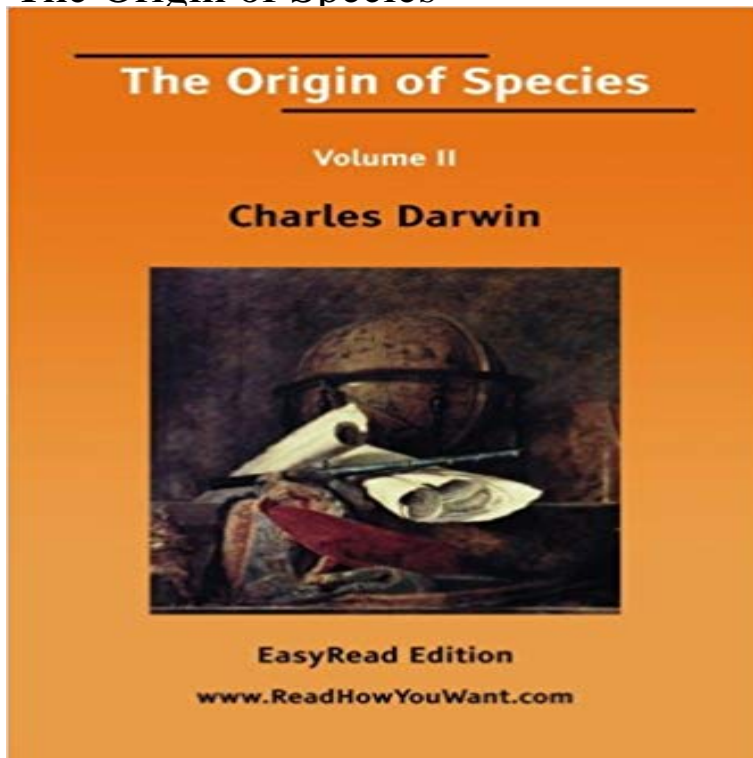


The Origin of Species
