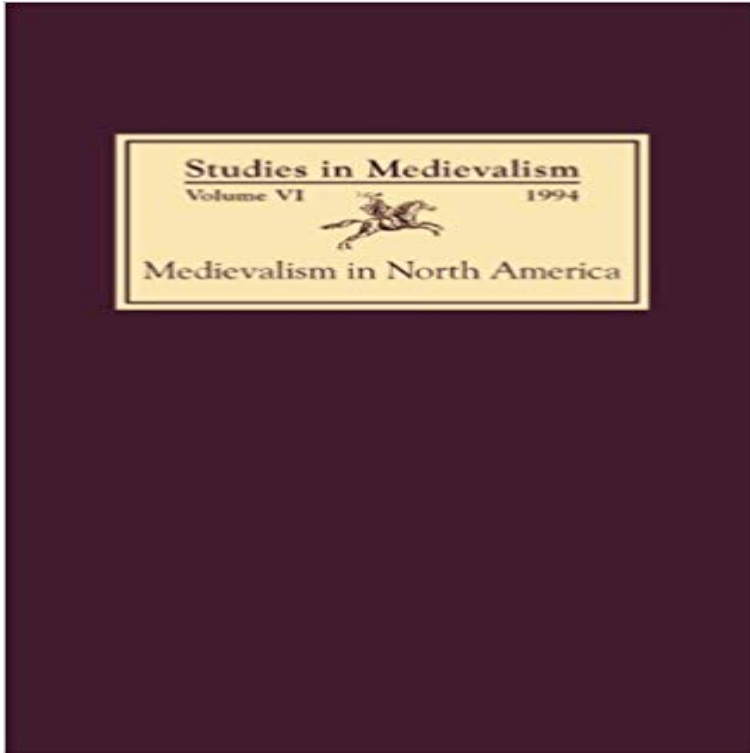


Studies in Medievalism VI: Medievalism in North America
