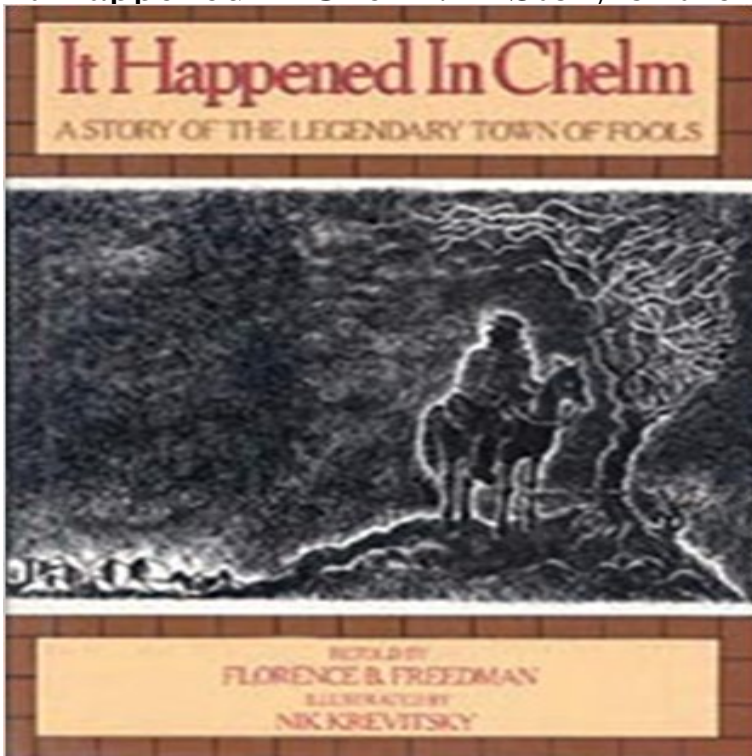


It Happened in Chelm: A Story of the Legendary Town of Fools
