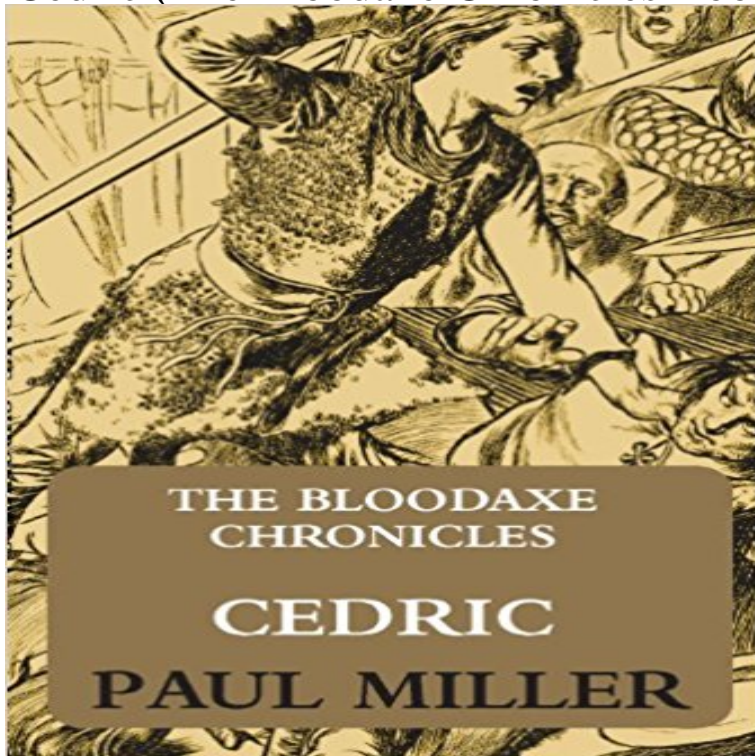


Cedric (The Bloodaxe Chronicles Book 3)
