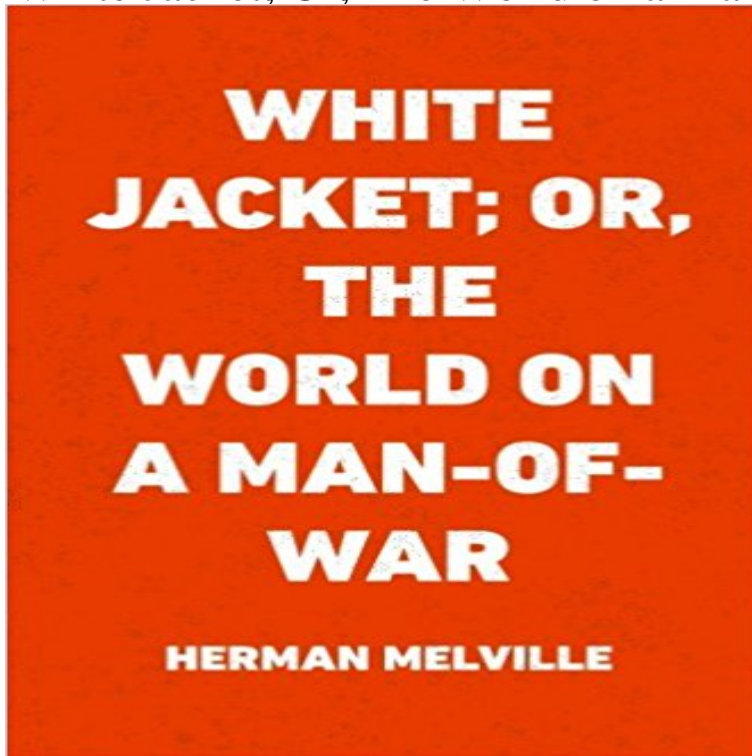


## White Jacket; Or, The World on a Man-of-War
