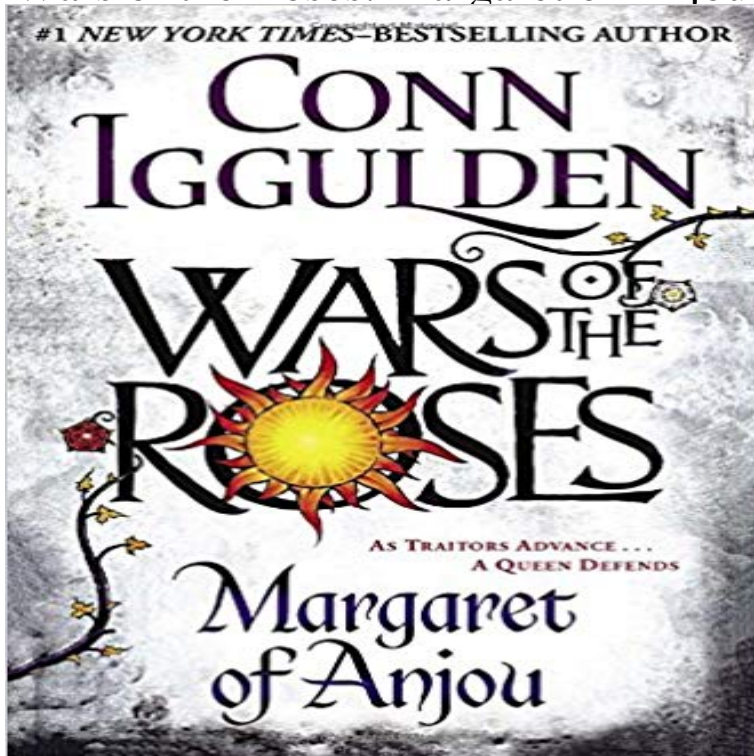


## Wars of the Roses: Margaret of Anjou
