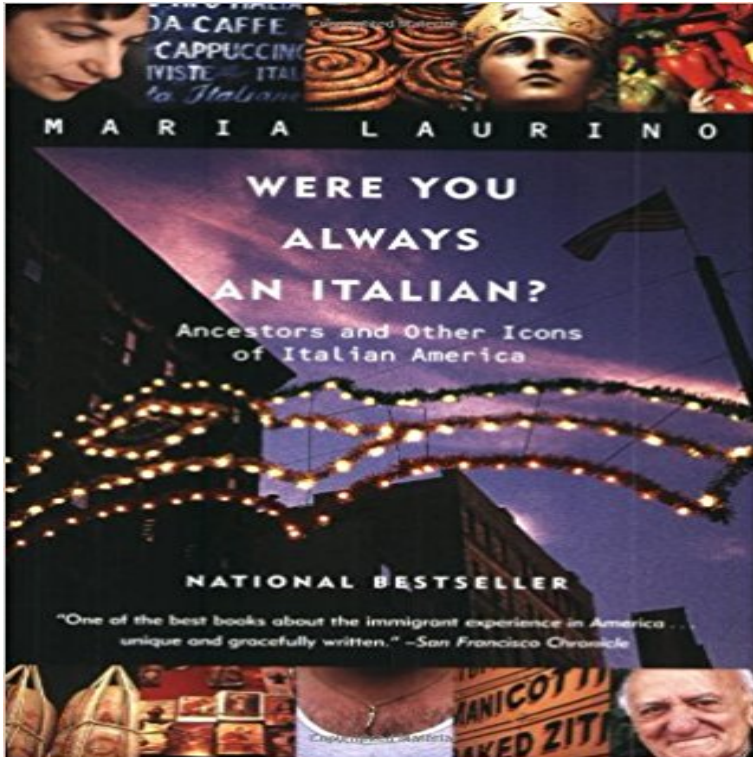


Were You Always an Italian?: Ancestors and Other Icons of Italian America
